Last Seasons 'behind closed doors' match at Old Trafford proved to be a milestone for the Foxes. Chasing a modest 155 to win Lightning were comfortable at 110-1 when the 15<sup>th</sup> over started needing just 45 to win with 9 wickets in hand When the principle run scorers Croft & Davies went in successive balls to Ackermann who then picked up the wicket of Bohannon 2 balls later things turned Lancs skipper Dane Vilas was then caught by Ackermann off Dieter Klein in the next over and Foxes won by 22 runs, having restricted Lancs to just 22 off the last 5 overs. Even more remarkable were the results in other matches which saw the Foxes qualify for the Quarter final

In the encounters down the years the 2017 game against Lancs at Liverpool stands out. Having completed a 4 day game against Sussex at Arundel the day before the Foxes were expected to travel the 260 miles to Liverpool to take on the Lightning. Leics were set a challenging 174 to win. When Matt Pillans was run out of the 5<sup>th</sup> ball of the last over 2 were required. Upstep Ackers, making his T20 debut in the UK he smashed the last ball for 6. Foxes won by 3 wickets !!
