The game at Edgbaston in the B&H Cup in 1996 was notable for a man of the match performance by South African Sean Pollock. Making his List A debut in the UK for Warwickshire, Pollock returned the best bowling by any player in A List cricket against the Foxes. His 6-21 off his 10 overs included 5 maidens and not just a Hat Trick but 4 wkts in 4 balls. Gregor Macmillan opening the batting was first to go for 4. Followed by Whitaker, Robinson & Maddy. Having taken the wicket of Vince Wells the over before Foxes were reduced to 9-5 after only 3 overs
