Lewis Hill is the only member of the current Foxes squad to have featured in a winning List A match against Notts Outlaws. In 2016 Leicestershire set the visitors 279 at Grace Rd who fell 8 runs short. Since then Foxes have lost 4 & 2 were abandoned

Peter Handscomb's 5 catches behind the stumps against Kent, was the 5th time a Leicestershire keeper had taken 5 in a list A game. Paul Nixon being the only keeper with more when he pouched 6 in a Sunday league match against Essex in 1994.

Roman Walker's 6 wicket haul in the last round was the 10th instance of a Fox taking 6 wickets. No Leicestershire player has taken 7. Chris Wright also took 6 in last seasons match against Notts but Charl Willoughby has the best figures with 6-16 against Somerset in 2005
