The Foxes have a good overall record against Vikings having won 16 of the 31 games played. At Grace Rd there have been 16 games, Foxes have won 10 with 4 lost.

The 2015 match in June resulted in a tie. Chasing 143 to win the Vikings required 1 run off the last ball when Ben Raine trapped Adil Rashid LBW. Foxes did't make things easy bowling a total of 14 wides in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ tied match in Leicestershire T20 history.

Foxes win at Durham on Sunday sees them still at the bottom of the table. In the years since the format was $\mathbf{2}$ groups and 14 group games it has needed 7 wins and 15 points to qualify for the knock out stages. There are $\mathbf{2}$ instances of sides qualifying with $\mathbf{6}$ wins but in both instances the points total was boosted to 15 by abandoned matches.

6 wins from the remaining 8 matches would be the minimum to stand a chance of qualification
