The run chase on a couple of days ago to beat Somerset of 327-6 was the highest score made by the Foxes to win a List A game but not the highest batting second. In 2016 at Grace Road, Leicestershire scored 329-9 but failed to reach Durham's total of 340.

The previous highest run chase to win a game was also against Somerset in 2013 when set 324 to win Foxes made the total with 7 balls to spare.

With qualification for the quarter finals being the top 3, there is still a chance of Foxes progressing. They have to beat Northants to finish on 9 points. We need Glamorgan to beat Yorkshire & one of Derbyshire to beat Surrey or Warks to beat Somerset. If Yorks beat Glamorgan then both Surrey and Somerset would have to lose
