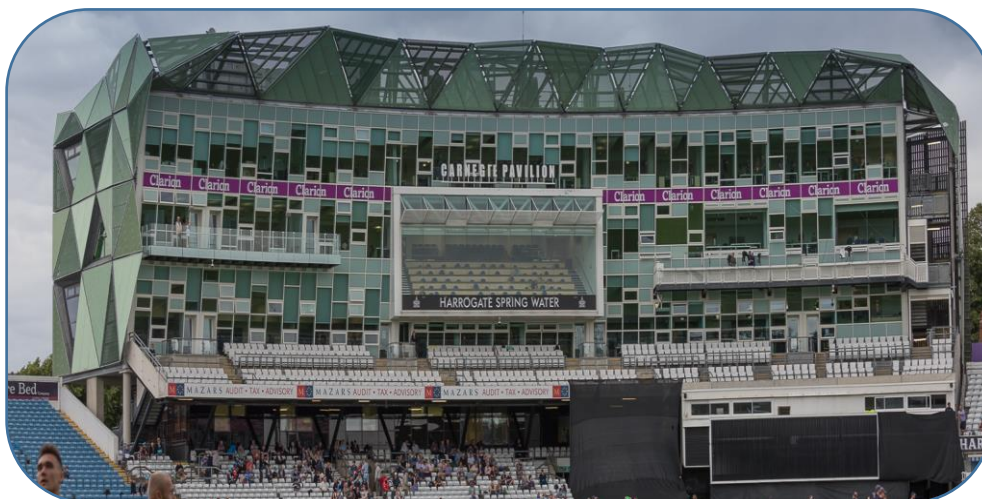


Home & Away.....

This will be the first meeting between the 2 sides at anything other than Grace Rd or The Riverside. Quite what the atmosphere will be like in a big test match ground without fans and no local interest remains to be seen.

One of the more unusual meetings between the 2 sides was the abandoned game at Grace Rd in 2011 when rain prevented any play after the first 5 overs. However in that time Foxes had made 58, with Josh Cobb scoring 54 off 26 balls and Andrew McDonald his opening partner just 4 off 4 balls. Cobb was bowled by Blackwell with the last ball of the 5th over and the umpires promptly took the players off never to return
