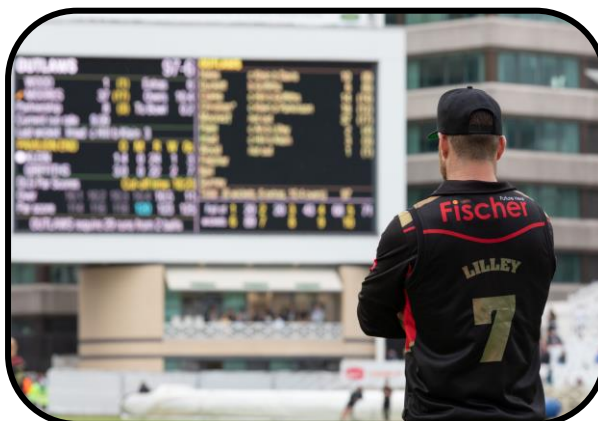


Trent Bridge Triumph or more rain??



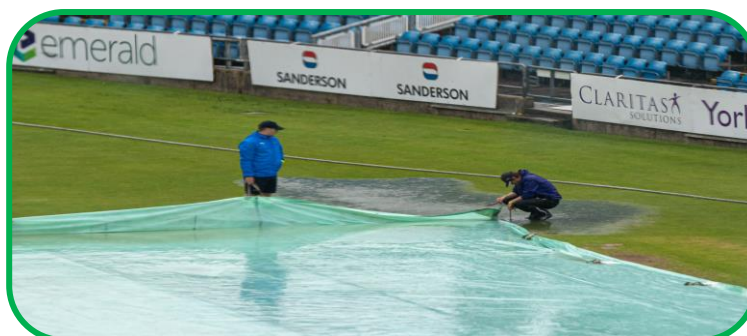

The highest total of 203-5 by Foxes against the Outlaws at Trent Bridge in 2017 saw a 54 ball 100 by Cameron Delport.
